2NOT1 promotes the safety and well-being of children by implementing strategies to keep fathers involved and families together.

Changing the lives of children...

2NOT1 Programs

- **“High Road” Parenting Education Program** “Strengthen families through Advocacy and Education.” This training is provided to parents and residents in the community as a resource to increase their capacity as parents and leaders.
- **Make Fatherhood Normal” Discussions** These monthly discussions were created through collaborative efforts to address issues specific fathers need to manage as parents. As of this report over 300 participants have participated in the discussions.
- **Teen Fatherhood University**, (TFU!), developed to support young males and fathers in prevention and responsible fatherhood. 90 young fathers received on-going support and resources to date.
- **theBLUEPRINT Rites of Passage (ROP)** is a mentoring program for boys transitioning from adolescence to maturity, and over 120 African American boys received ongoing mentoring.
- **Parent Advocate Program** provides mentorship to parents engaged in the Department of Community Based Services Child Protection System, and over 150 parents have received resources or direct services from our office.
- **Non-traditional Instruction (NTI) Learning Hubs** offer JCPS students a safe learning environment that supports their virtual NTI educational needs during the pandemic.

2NOT1 Significant Moments

- **2NOT1 was** recognized as a non-profit in the state of Kentucky and officially recognized as a non-profit with 501-C3 status in 2007.
- **Inaugural Fatherhood Conference** at the Muhammad Ali Center. To date, 5 successful fatherhood conferences have promoted and raised awareness to responsible fatherhood for over 300 fathers and practitioners.
- **Mother’s Forums** that encouraged mothers in the struggle of single parenting through resources, support, and peer-parenting from other parents to date over 90 mothers supported.
- **Annual Fatherhood Cook-out** promotes spending quality time with children and peer-parenting between fathers. To date, over 3000 served.
- 2NOT1 gained support from **Metro United Way, Community Foundation – One Louisville, Jewish Heritage Fund for Excellence, Humana, Gheens, Kosair Charities, Brown Forman, Genesis** and various community supporters.
